Treloggan footpath crossing – Renewal work

We wanted to give you notice that we will be working at Treloggan footpath crossing. We will be installing a miniature stop light system (red stop and green go lights), new fencing, crossing approaches and signage.

Work will take place **during the day** between the hours of **8:30am to 4:30pm** from **Monday 28 February to Tuesday 8 March** but please be aware these dates may change.

Please note, we'll need to close the crossing for the duration of the work and a **diversion** will be in place. A map of the diversion can be seen at the bottom of this letter.

The system will be in use to the public by **5pm** on the **Tuesday 8 March**. Please ensure you read the instructions for the new system below.

Pedestrians using the foot crossing should follow the below instructions:

- 1. Check that the green light shows**
- 2. Cross quickly, ensuring that the gate is closed behind you**
- 3. If there is no light, do not cross. Please telephone the crossing operator, using the number on the signage.**

For cyclist users, please follow the below instructions:

- 1. Dismount**
- 2. Check that the green light shows**
- 3. Cross quickly, ensuring that the gate is closed behind you**
- 4. If there is no light, do not cross. Please telephone the crossing operator using the number on the crossing signage.**
